



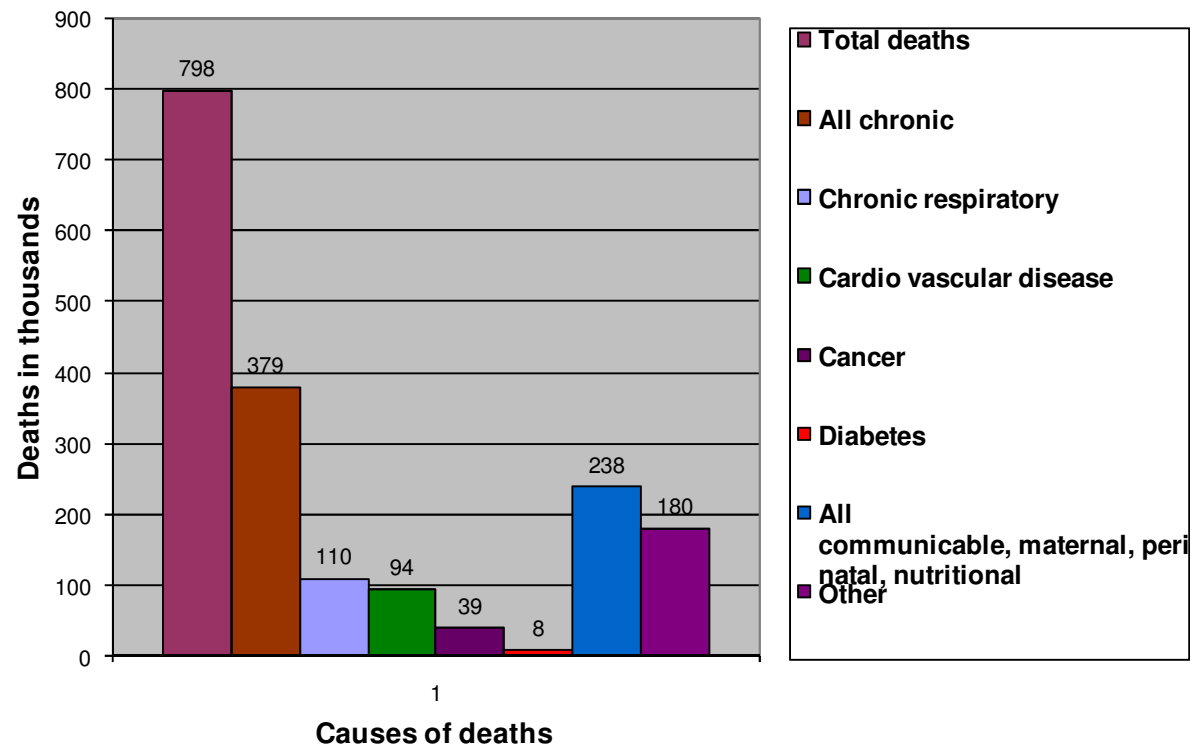

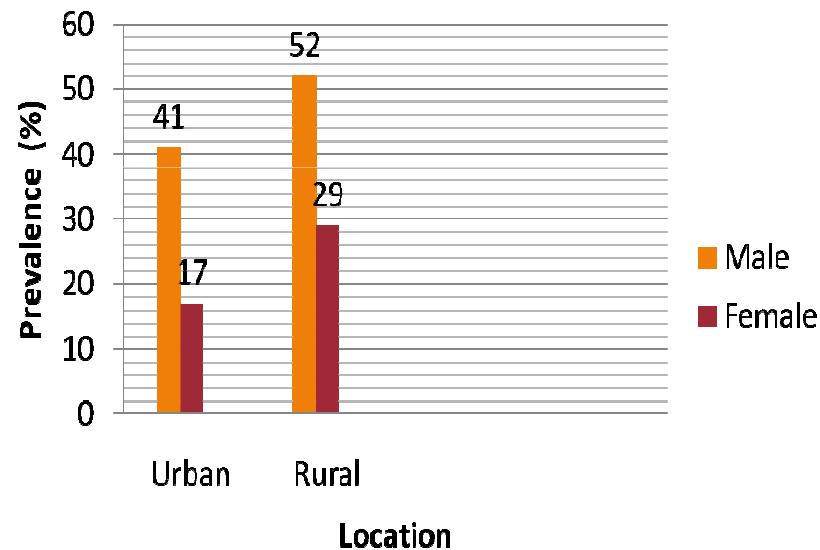
#2 Improve Local Data

- No plans to capture morbidity/mortality

- Risk Factor, Self Reported Illness, Health Seeking Behavior (n=39,000)

- **Nutrition research and initiatives by ICDDR,B and BRAC; work with National Nutrition Programme**



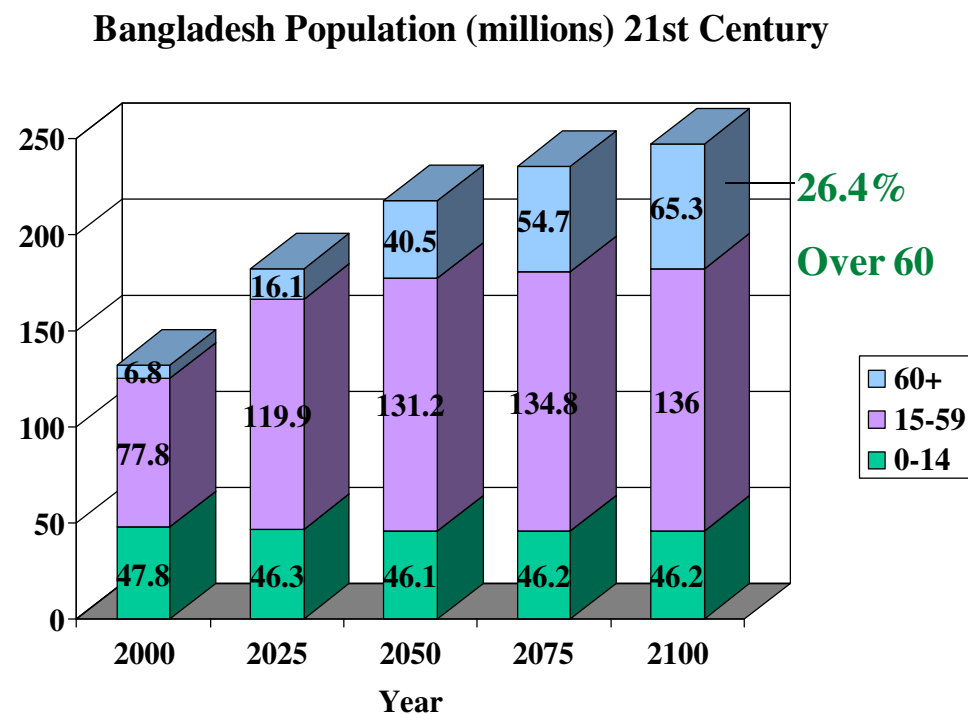
#9 Collaboration to Improve Access to CVD diagnostics, medicines and technology

- 1 academic medical centre, 4 hospitals, 18 clinics



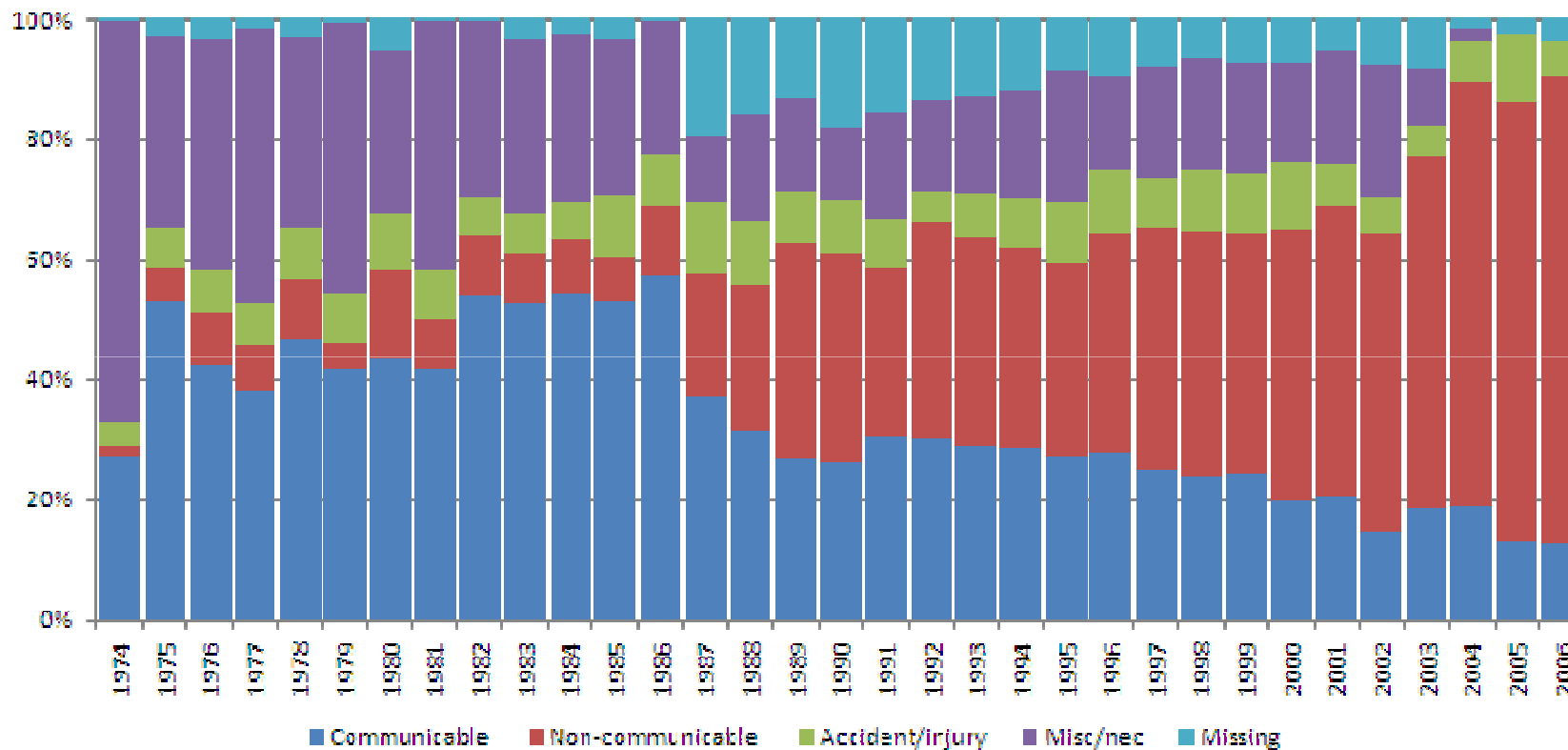
